INTRODUCTION TO THE TRIPS EMPLOYABILITY SOLAR:

This set of resources are designed to be used by tutors and Industry Placement Coordinators delivering employability-based workshops for T Level or Transition year learners. The aim is to introduce learners to the importance of Employability skills and prepare them for their Industry Placement or any work-based activity within their industry. The series of resources are available in different formats, depending on the preference of the college however they are predominantly created in Nearpod to utilise the interactive features.

This is the first part of a series of 10 resources, one for each of the 10 employability skills highlighted by employers. Due to changes to the way we work post COVID-19, we have looked at how this has impacted working practices becoming aware that working from home is now commonplace, we have applied a blended approach to learning and therefore all lessons can be accessed online and can be delivered remotely or in class. The set lessons can run at the students' pace or worked through with the tutors and resources are adaptable to suit each tutor and their group requirements. 

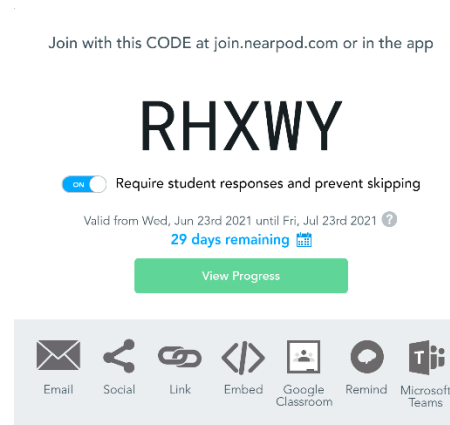
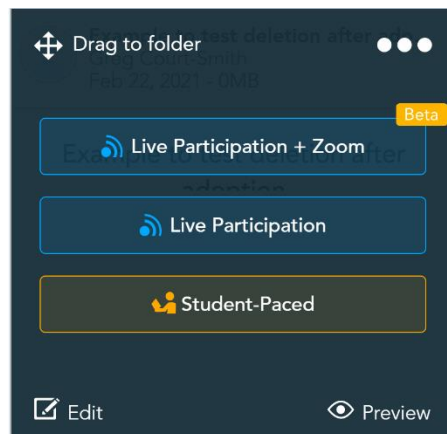
