Leaders are solution-focused, innovative, and forward-thinking in delivering a high-quality learning environment is a common expectation.

Ethical Leadership

Leaders understand and practise ethical leadership, including consideration of ethical decision-making.

Role Model and Cultivate a Positive Working Culture

Leaders create and maintain a positive working culture within the organisation, with attention to professional development, work life balance, inclusivity, social awareness, and emotional maturity.

Strategic Leadership

Leaders understand and contribute to organisational governance, strategy, quality assurance, and sustainability. **Effective Communication**

Leaders utilise effective written and verbal communication skills to build professional relationships with both internal and external stakeholders.
